Instructions for POSTER Presentations

These instructions are intended to assist you as you prepare for your poster presentation with respect to both presentation details and effective communication hints. Location of your poster presentation will be available when you register. Formal poster presentations with author attendance are Wednesday, March 11, 3-4 PM (odd numbered posters) and from 4-5 PM (even numbered posters).

At the Conference

All posters will be up during the whole conference.

Posters can be put up as early as Monday, March 9th at 4 PM and must be put up no later than Wednesday, March 11 at 3 PM in time for the first formal poster session. Materials to put up your poster can be obtained at the registration desk. Posters can also be informally viewed at anytime throughout the conference and therefore it is preferred that they are not removed before Friday 4:30 PM. Any unclaimed posters will be discarded after the conference.

Preparing Your Poster

Please prepare your poster for a maximum size of **36 inches (width) x 45 inches (height)**.
